New work

New rocks range pieces have been completed, vessels, vases, bowls and hug mugs. These vessels are wheel thrown in a smooth white clay and hand painted with a range of underglazes and stains. Inspired by the beautiful east coast and Hawley beach rocks.

s a I a d - large salad bowl hand crafted, textured rock like finish and glazed in breaking almond and iron oxide wash.



r o c k s - wheel thrown vase in white raku, texturised rock surface and hand painted with stains and chalks.
Glazed inside clear with copper wash.



v i s t a - wheel thrown vessel in an iron rich clay, decorated using slips and carving inspired by the headland, glazed with almond and clear glazes



m o u n t a i n - jug, wheel thrown and altered using an iron rich clay, decorated using slips and carving inspired by the Narawntapu mountain ranges. Layered glazes inside and out with iron oxide wash.

Workshops

Workshops continue to be busy and a great introduction to your own pottery journey, I'm currently running 2 workshops per month, this includes group bookings.

More recently has seen the introduction of the "Mould your masterpiece" workshops where participants can bring an idea or inspiration to bring to life. This has seen some great ideas and challenges presented. Group workshops are also keeping me very busy behind the scenes!
